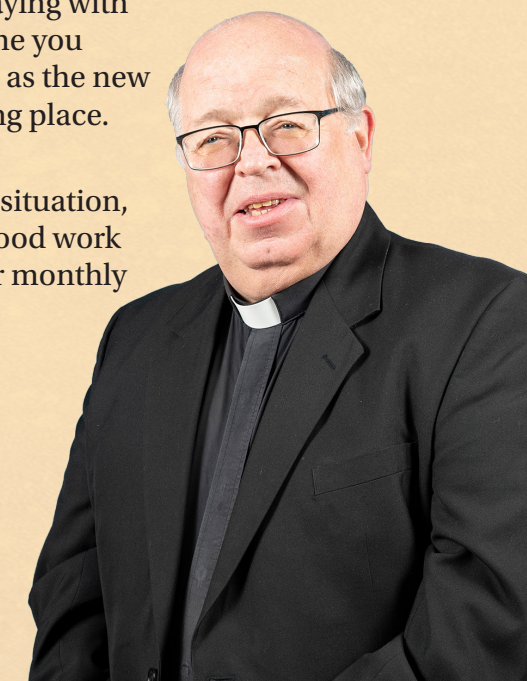
Let me also mention devotions and fundraisers which serve to support the parish and to foster a sense of joyous community spirit while always supporting our mission to grow in faith and service.

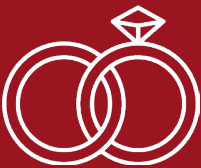

New to Our Parish



Father Craig Alexander became a new Parochial Vicar to Connellsville on June 17. He grew up in Highspire, Pa., and went to the First United Methodist Church, where he came to know God and believe in Jesus. He enlisted in the Marine Corps in 1979, where he spent the next 13 years without practicing faith. He received an associate degree from Harrisburg Area Community College and worked for PennDOT for 20 years. While attending RCIA classes, he began discussions about becoming a priest, which caused him to pray and ask God if He was calling him to be His priest. He entered Holy Mother Church in 2005, then entered the seminary in 2018 and was ordained a Catholic priest of the Diocese of Greensburg on June 1, 2024.



Mary Allison is our new Regional Director of Faith Formation, Connellsville-Mount Pleasant Region, covering eight parishes. She was born and raised in Burke, Va., and majored in history and religious studies at The College of William and Mary, graduating in 2014. She worked for the Department of Defense after graduation, then became a nanny in New Zealand. While working toward her Master of Arts degree at Duke University, which she received in 2018, she became a part-time youth minister at Saint Catherine of Siena Parish in Wake Forest, N.C. She became Director of Catechetical Ministries at Saint Patrick Parish in Anchorage, Alaska, in 2020, then worked as a Director of Religious Education at Saint Ann Parish in Midland, Texas. She arrived in the Diocese of Greensburg in November 2023.
