Strong parish and extra-parochial organizations such as the Holy Name and Rosary Altar Societies and the Knights of Columbus do much to serve our parish and community, including regular meals through Mosaic. Let me also mention the Ascension Italian Festival and our spaghetti dinners, which support the parish and foster a sense of community and service.
